with Elmer and Marilyn Sira to Mexico, Florida, U.S.A., and here.

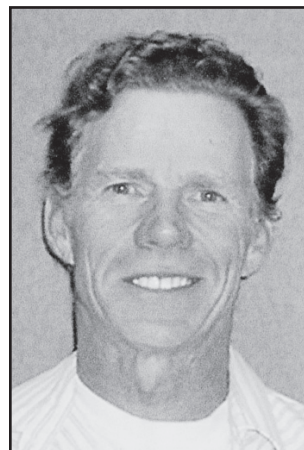

## Local clubs get SLGA grants

REGINA — Clubs in Davidson, Craik, Liberty and Bethune are among the recipients of Saskatchewan's latest round of charitable gaming grants.

The government announced Thursday that more than \$2.3 million in payments was being distributed to more than 900 groups and organizations across the province by the Saskatchewan Liquor and Gaming Authority (SLGA). The program provides a grant equal to 25 per cent of the net revenues that groups raise through licensed bingos, raffles, break-open ticket sales, Texas Hold 'Em poker and Monte Carlo events. Among the local recipients are the following:

- Bethune and District Lions Club, \$1,128.44.
- Craik Agricultural Society, \$264.25.
- Davidson Kinsmen Club, \$561.69.
- Liberty Service Club, \$157.75.
